Classes being offered this WINTER are as follows:

Acting for Camera (Ages 10-17)

This class offers an introduction to auditioning for a commercial, film, and television shoot! Students will learn the tools and tips an actor needs when transitioning from stage to film, and understanding the specific choices to make with a script and the techniques it takes to draw your audience in!

Advanced Young Actors: The Tempest (Ages 9-13)

In this 12 week session, students will learn the magic of Shakespeare through putting on an adaptation of The Tempest! Students will learn fun facts and history about Shakespeare incorporating theatre games and activities as well as basic auditioning techniques that will help them audition for the production! Once cast (everyone receives a role!) students will begin rehearsing the script all the while using different aspects of performance including character development and scene study! They will also be able to help design basic costuming and makeup as well! Our final class will be a full hour production of The Tempest!

Building Characters (Ages 9-12)

Building characters is the foundation of acting at all levels! It is a wonderful way for you to explore what it's like to live in someone else's shoes! In this class, students will learn about the important tools an actor needs: body, voice and imagination in order to create original characters and fun skits with their peers. Through a variety of fun exercises, improvisations, and scene work, students will develop personal understanding of playing an action, being in the moment, and other fundamentals of acting. Share day on the final day of class for family and friends!

Creative Kids (Ages 6-8)

Do you love stories? Playing? Having fun? In this class, students will start exploring the world of theatre through acting and storytelling exercises. By exploring the world of a children's book, students will create their own short play that they will present to family and friends on the last day of class!

Your Inner Voice (Ages 11-15)

Through improvisation, writing, and scene work, students will develop monologues and scenes using material and stories from their own lives! The class will also learn how to interact in a performance ensemble, and further refine acting and movement skills. Students will create a series of pieces that highlight each student's personal narrative that will be shared with family and friends at the conclusion of the session!



Intro to Acting (Ages 7-9) (Ages 9-12)

This class introduces new students to the exciting world of theatre and performance! Through engaging and fun games and exercises, students will learn the key elements of an Actor's Toolbox: Voice, Body, Imagination, Concentration and Cooperation! They will learn basic theatrical terms, stagecraft, the exploration of voice and moment through character development and improvisation techniques!

Intro to Improv (Ages 9-12)

This lively class will use improvisational exercises to teach students the importance of listening, saying YES, being present and using those skills to create characters, and building worlds. Improvisational acting is based in comedy, and we encourage silliness and fun! Improv has many benefits, including bringing a sense of calm in dealing with the unknown, feelings of confidence, and a decreased sense of anxiety! This class is open to new students, but returning students are welcomed too!

Intro to Playwriting for Adults (Ages 17 & Up)

Always wanted to write a play, but didn't know where to start? Maybe you have some ideas, but just don't know how to set up a scene or build characters? Have some scenes already written, but want feedback and encouragement to KEEP ON WRITING? This is the class for you! In a workshop-structured environment, we will explore writing for the theatre through practice and discussion. We will study major components of playwriting, including action, dialogue, and character! Students will complete and workshop writing assignments with the encouragement to provide and receive feedback. We may also study the work of contemporary playwrights and have the opportunity to see Playhouse on Park's production of Indecent. No previous playwriting experience necessary! Budding writers welcomed! The class will conclude with a showcase of selected pieces performed in a Reader's Theatre format, to an audience of friends and family.

Prerequisite: Must be a confident reader and writer. Students must be able to handle reading material with mature content.

Production and the Creative Team (Ages 11-15)

This class is open to new and returning students who would like to learn more about the different people and jobs involved in creating a production, in addition to the actors onstage. Students will learn about the fundamentals of directing and design, and will apply those concepts to imagining the set, lighting, and costumes for their own production as if they were the directors and designers hired to work on the piece. On the final day, students will "pitch" their unique production to family and friends, AND members of Playhouse on Park's Production and Artistic departments in the style of a mock interview with the producers who



would be putting on this production. Production selection to be determined by the Teaching Artist! This is an EXCITING way to get to know the ins and outs of a production from behind the scenes!

Improv: Level II (Ages 9-12)

Just finished the Improv for beginners class this past Fall and want MORE? LEVEL UP to Improv II with us! Maybe you took an Intro class somewhere else and want to continue on? LEVEL UP with us! In this class your creativity, risk-taking, and confidence will continue to grow! The exercises in Improv II will not only help you build the necessary skills that allow improv to become effortless and enjoyable for everyone involved, but it will also teach you how to become more mindful of others and aware that, in improv, anything is everything!

Story to Stage (Ages 6-8)

Students will explore their abilities in storytelling through an adaptation of a children's book. Exercises and games will focus on the introduction of basic acting techniques, storytelling, puppetry, creating a character, and fun team-building games. Share day on the final day of class will be for family and friends to witness a small staged production! All students will receive a copy of the book as a keepsake!
